



The government has conducted a lot of research on children's attainment and how it is affected by absence. There is a clear link between poor attendance at school and lower academic achievement. Pupils who are regularly absent from school quickly develop gaps in their learning so progress is slowed and their ability to meet or exceed related learning expectations is reduced. It is very important that your child attends school every day.
